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Gods love can empower us to walk Christ-like even in the most challenging of circumstances. And, my friend, it is entirely worth it. It will not go unnoticed. Take your answers from above and write and declare the following: *Gods love will empower me to love like Jesus in my situation with*\_\_\_\_\_.

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Remember, because Jesus first loved you, you *are* the virtuous woman. That is your identity. And He is your full reward.

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Write and declare the following with your answers from above: *God is redeeming my\_\_\_\_\_ (example: financial situation...). He is bringing me victory, because He loves me. He is my Kinsman-Redeemer!*
